

Steps to writing a high-quality compare-and-contrast essay

The task of this essay is to compare-and-contrast two subjects. Although they belong to the same category, these topics will be different. Two novels written at the same period on different types of pets might be compared and contrasted with "[essay writing service](#)". It can be challenging to write a single subject essay! Even with two topics to cover, where do you start?



As such, you were given two topics for your research. Take note of the comparisons and differences. Is this going to affect how you write? You might be surprised by what you've discovered. Create a thesis statement. What are the similarities and differences between your two topics? How do they differ and how do they differ at the same time? Prepare a strong thesis statement by using your research. Organize your essay into an outline. You can write your outline based on the structure above. Make a note of all the main points. You will not forget anything this way. Your essay needs to be written. Your essay should follow the structure that you created. Don't rush this process, or you will appear hurried in your writing. Proofread and edit your work. The presentation of your essay is also important, so don't skip this step.

The following steps will help you write an effective compare-and-contrast essay.

1. **Select a topic**

To write a meaningful compare-and-contrast essay, make sure that your two subjects are different, but still comparable. It makes sense to ask an [essay writer](#) if it's critical and complex. However, it can be easy to write your essay on your own if you have chosen the correct topic. For example, if your essay is about two different items then make sure to make it about the same entities such as two historical figures, rather than choosing a politician and an artist if you want to write about two different historical figures.

Several examples:

- The works of Modigliani and Picasso
- Mozart and A. Salieri
- Meat eaters and vegetarians
- The ability to think both philosophically and mathematically
- The differences between extroverts and introverts
- The Fatalist and the Voluntarian
- Catholicism and Orthodox Christianity
- A democracy and a totalitarian state
- Millennials and Generation Z

1. **Run a similarity/differences brainstorm**

Separate the similarities from the differences and make a list of each. Venn diagrams can be extremely helpful if you are a visual learner. Then create two circles that overlap each other, one for each topic you intend to compare. Separating the differences from the similarities, the ones that overlap are written within. The visual aid helps summarize similarities and differences in a clear manner. To see what topics you could write about, you simply need to glance at your Venn diagram. As a good Essay Writer, consider writing your lists on a blank piece of paper and flipping it over so that you can focus on one subject at a time. Keeping the characteristics of different subjects parallel is a good strategy. This will make structuring a good argument easier.

1. **Focus on the point you want to make**

By comparing-and-contrasting two topics, a writer can make a meaningful statement about an important issue. Which of the lists you've created strikes you the most as significant? Are there any similarities or differences between these topics? You will argue that point.

1. **Decide how you will organize**

Comparative essays can be structured in several different ways. A detailed account of one subject could be followed by a detailed account of another.

Comparing and contrasting men and women is a great way to illustrate this. In your first paragraph, list two characteristics common to women (they tend to be more compassionate; they are good multitaskers) along with some common to men (they sacrifice themselves for the good of others). Then, in your second paragraph, list two characteristics common to men. (Men are generally stronger and more skilled technologically).

It is also possible to go through the essay point by point. Your first body paragraph may read: "While men may not always be compassionate towards other people's problems, they are more likely to try and solve them." You could also focus on similarities first before discussing differences. If this is your problem, the first body paragraph(s) could read: "Men and women respond best to appreciation and worth when they feel valued." Choose a structure that makes sense to your point.

1. **Outline your work**

Depending on your chosen structure, outline. The three main body paragraphs of an essay are the introductory paragraph, the three body paragraphs, and the conclusion. To balance your two subjects, you might want to include four body paragraphs.

1. **Provide evidence to support your thesis**

Research, read, and use personal experience to support your assertions as you [write my essay](#). Using anecdotes from your friends about their pets will help you bolster your argument for cats vs. dogs. ("My

roommate's dog always greets him when he gets home from work, but my cat never does."). If you are writing an essay comparing and contrasting Shakespeare and Keats, include over a dozen quotes from their works to support your claims. Any information you include should be accompanied by an explanation of why it is relevant to your argument.

1. Use strong transitional words in your essay

You can use transition words to make your essay flow smoothly from one point to the next. In comparison, use words such as "both," "likewise," and "similarly." In contrast, words like "yet" "on the other hand," and "while" are ideal.

1. Revise carefully and proofread

Upon finishing your essay, read it several times to ensure it follows proper grammar, spelling, and punctuation. If you use a word processing program, use its spelling and grammar checker. You might miss mistakes if you do not have a second set of eyes to check them. We often miss silly mistakes in our work because we have difficulty reading it objectively.

You can write a compare-and-contrast essay that will surely impress your audience by following these steps.
